Here are three important takeaways from this Bible study: Third, the tenets of the social justice movement are antithetical to biblical teachings and therefore anti-Christian. Believers, and especially Christian leaders, need to overcome social and cultural vertigo — and spiritual vertigo as well by grounding their judgments in objective truth, especially God's Word. Pastors need to be preaching against the social justice movement, and Christians in the pews need to be warning their brothers and sisters in Christ about it.
